Class limit of 12.

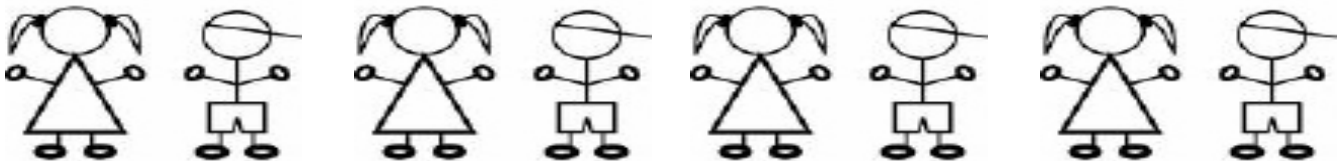
