



8th Hour After School Program Information

8th hour is a free after school study/tutorial program available to all BJHS students. **Students can come from 2:40-3:30 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays** to receive help from two BJHS teachers.

This is a highly structured time of study. Discipline issues will result in a student's removal. If a student cannot follow these guidelines, he/she will be given a verbal warning. The second instance will result in the students being taken to the office, and the parent will be called. A third instance will result in the student being asked not to attend 8th hour for two weeks.

8th hour expectations:

- Take care of the following before 8th hour begins:
 - Get books, paper, or other materials needed and sharpen pencils
 - Go to the restroom, get drinks and/or call home
 - Talk with friends
 - Eat snacks
- During 8th hour you will:
 - Be assisted by a teacher when you indicate that you have a question by raising your hand
 - Work silently and steadily on academic work until you are dismissed
 - Ignore distractions
 - Have a good and respectful attitude

Transportation is the responsibility of the parent. Erie Transit can be used after school for a small fee. Please call 734-242-6766 to schedule a pickup time. Students will be ready for pick up at 3:30 in front of the building.

8th hour teachers will call home if your son /daughter does not come on the scheduled day. **If the student will not be attending the program but is signed up, please place a note in the 8th hour mailbox or call the main office at 850-6200.** This is important to assure the safety of each student.
