DOES ANYONE NEED TO TAKE SEGMENT I DRIVERS EDUCATION?

Community Education is offering 4 classes this summer. The first class starts June 11th at 8:00 am in PO-H. The second class starts June 11th at 10:00 am in PO-H. The third class starts July 9th at 8:00 am in PO-H. The fourth class and final class of the summer starts July 19th at 8:00 am in PO-G.

DOES ANYONE NEED TO TAKE SEGMENT 2 DRIVERS EDUCATION?

Students if you have had your level 1 certificate for at least three months you are eligible to take Segment II. Community Education is offering 3 more Segment II classes.

The first class starts May 29th at 2:30 pm in PO-G.

The second class starts July 9th at 10:00 am in PO-H.

The final class for the summer is July 30th at 10:00 am in PO-H.
