Curriculum *The curriculum contains over 200 course offerings and allows students flexibility in designing schedules to meet their needs. Special features of the curriculum include: comprehensive special education program, seven (7) AP classes, seven (7) honors courses, vocational/technical training, work-study programs, dual-enrollment for students taking college classes, and an alternative high school completion program. The*





school year is comprised of three twelve week terms. Students take five (5) classes per day, five days a week.
