BPS Need to Know...

- **JRE Snack Policy:** Not all grade levels will have a snack time. Please refer to your student's teachers regarding this policy. The classroom snack policy is "Fresh is Best". Students may bring a fresh fruit or vegetable if they choose to have a classroom snack. This policy supports the BPS Wellness Policy.
- **Birthday Treats:** BPS has a policy of no food, candy, or gum for birthday treats. The school announces birthdays daily, hands out a birthday bracelet, and the JRE PTO provides students with a book during the month of their birthday.

A look at the first day...

The First Day of School-Morning Drop Off/Pick Up

Here is how our first day will look.....

1. Bus: Students ride the bus to and from school. Staff will be available to help students get to their classrooms as they are released from the buses. They will be released in staggered groups. All students will enter through the main doors and walk down to their classrooms.

Bus stop information is available on the Traversa Ride 360 Mobile App & website.

To get started with creating your account, you will need your child's Student ID number. Once your account is created, you will be able to use the mobile app to view the bus' progress along the route.

Please note that the Transportation staff is continuing to make adjustments to the routes as last minute student registrations come in. Please double check before the first day of school. Times will fluctuate at the start of a new school year until everyone settles down into a routine.

2. **JRE Loop:** Students must exit the vehicle on the passenger side only. Students must be able to independently exit the car. Our staff will not be able to open doors, lean in cars, undo seatbelts, etc. due to safety procedures that are in place.


3. Latchkey: There will be limited space available and students must be registered prior to the start of school. Call 734-850-6036 to register. https://bedford.ce.eleyo.com/child-care/1/latchkey

NOTE: Parents may NOT park in the north lot and walk students up to the building.

We need to keep all areas in front and back of the school clear for our students.

Jackman Road Elementary Loop Tags



If you will be using the loop to pick up your student(s), will need to fill out a form to get a loop number and car tag from the office. Please email nicci.harder@mybedford.us and she will send the link to fill out for a loop tag.

The drop off/pick up loop is in the back of the school. Please enter and exit the car on the passenger side. **Students will need to exit the car independently.**

Dismissal Procedures

LATCHKEY STUDENTS

Latchkey students will follow all guidelines set forth by the latchkey staff.

Latchkey students will go to the cafeteria at dismissal.

RIDING THE BUS

Front of School: All students will leave their classrooms and exit through the main doors. They will be released in staggered groups and adults will be there to help students find their bus.

PARENT PICK UP LOOP

Back of School: Students will exit the building at the hallway in which their classroom is located. There will be adults available to help students.


A Hall Back Doors: Kindergarten and first grade classrooms.

B Hall Back Doors: Second and third grade classrooms, and any student eating breakfast at school.

C Hall Back Doors: Fourth and fifth grade students.

About the Building...

Jackman Road Elementary is in the shape of a capital E. There are four hallways.



Main Hallway (Art, Music, Physical Education, Exploratory, Media Center, Young Fives, Reading Specialist, Health Room, and the Office are in this hallway.)

C Hallway (Latchkey, Grades 4 and 5 are in this hallway.)

B Hallway (The lunchroom, Grades 2 and 3 are in this hallway.)

A Hallway (Young Fives, Kindergarten, and Grade 1, are in this hallway.)

Jackman Road Elementary Lobby



Welcome to JRE!

The front lobby is where students riding the bus will enter the building.

NOTE: Adults may enter the building via the front lobby as well. Please use the door to the far left. This will get you to the JRE office.

Jackman Road Elementary Office

The JRE office is located in the main hall next to the lobby. Mrs. Krupp, Mrs. Lezon, and Mrs. Harder are ready to help you.

The Student Support Coordinator's, Principal's and Assistant Principal's offices are also located here.



Dropping Off/Picking Up Items

To better serve everyone we are asking that all parents park in front of the building (8:45 a.m.-3:00 p.m.). Please enter the main doors to the office. We are happy to help you with any needs.

Jackman Road Elementary Health Room

The Jackman Road Elementary Health room will be in the main office. The procedure to pick up a student in the health room will be as follows:

- Pull up to the front of the school.
- Call 734-850-6620 and let the staff know you are here or come into the office.
- Your student will be brought out to you. Please be prepared to show identification.

NOTE: Parents may drop of medication to the health room with the <u>Medical Authorization Form</u> by following the same procedure mentioned above.

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Jackman Road Elementary Positive Behavior Support





PBS stands for Positive Behavior Support. It is a program designed to teach respect, responsibility and safety at school. At JRE we hope to encourage students to continuously make good behavioral choices by implementing this program.

How the Program Works

Posters that highlight behavior expectations for all areas in the school, from classroom to office, and restrooms will remind students of what is expected from them in each area.

- All students and staff are taught the school-wide expectations.
- Students will receive frequent reviews of the expectations and are acknowledged when they demonstrate them.
- Most of the contact that students have with adults in the building is positive and prevents problem behavior from occurring.
- A PBS school provides a consistent, predictable, and fair use of consequences for all students.
